Stalls and Covered Pens: \$55.00 with 1 bag of shavings
A.P.H.A. fee: \$2.00 per horse per Judge (Fee waived for Solid Paint Bred Horses)

Registration: All horses must be registered with the American Paint Horse Association, except current year foals, which must be shown as unnamed. Amateurs, Novice Amateurs and Novice Youth must have a current card or apply for a temporary card through the Show Secretary. You are responsible for knowing all the rules that pertain to qualifying for awards offered by organizations approving this show. Horses must be pre-entered with at least one entry per horse, or a post entry fee of \$25.00 will be charged. Send entries and a photocopy of papers, plus Youth, Amateur, and Broodmare cards, if applicable, to the Show Secretary. Payment need not accompany entries.
