New Business: There was discussion on parking in the barn area.

Everyone needs to think about the people stalling around them. Please do not tie your horse to one side of your trailer and your dog to the other side. Don't park you truck in front of someone's pen making it hard, if not impossible for them to get their horses in and out. Show management would not want to make the decision to no longer allow parking in the barns. This is a safety issue so all exhibitors need to do their part.

Discussion followed on new ways to help the youth club fund their scholarship. Warm up trail was a suggestion favored by many. Also, selling patter books for a small fee. Both of these ideas will be in place for the September show. Also, if you would like a specific number for next year, they will be available in 2008. They will come laminated and there will be 2 numbers which will be yours for the season. There will be a small charge for this and the proceeds will go to the Youth scholarship fund.
