2010 NEVADA PAINT HORSE CLUB YEAR END AWARD RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. To be eligible: Owner or lessee of the horse must be a member in good standing. If horse is leased, a lease must be on file with the Secretary of the NPHC. (Exception: Walk/Trot Exhibitors do not have to own the horse as these classes are non-APHA approved classes). The date of lease to become effective when received by the Secretary, whom will then be responsible for supplying a copy to the Point Keeper. All entry fees and other show liabilities to the treasury of this club must be paid by October 31, 2010.
 - $\underline{\mathbf{A}}$. Any member, as stipulated above, must attend and personally sign in at two (2) business meetings during the year (2010).
 - B. Recipients must show under eight (8) judges in the event for which they are qualifying.

 This shall include the horse being exhibited at one of the NPHC's two judge shows. (Keep in mind that you must "qualify" in each class that offers a year-end award by exhibiting at one of NPHC's two judge shows.) ONLY classes that meet this requirement will be counted for any NPHC Class, High Point, and Special Awards.
 - C. Two (2) ENPHC shows have been approved by the NPHC Board of Directors for 2010. The points accumulated at these shows are bonus points and will only count towards individual class awards. Exhibiting at either of these two shows *will not count* toward your eight (8) NPHC judge requirement for year-end, high point, or special awards.
- 2. For all awards, only APHA approved shows sponsored or approved by the NPHC will count for awards.
- <u>3</u>. For the method of tabulation of points, see the point chart in this directory. In addition, Grand Champions receive two (2) bonus points and Reserve Champions receive one (1) bonus point.
- <u>4</u>. All classes that the NPHC offers and that have a qualified recipient will receive awards. NPHC will give awards to the Champion and Reserve Champion in each event. Additional awards for 3rd through 6th will be given if approved by the NPHC Board of Directors. In order to qualify for any individual class award, a minimum of four points must be earned.
- <u>5.</u> The year-end awards deadline is November 25, 2010. If you have a request for your year-end awards, please contact Sharon before that date.
- 6. All questions shall be referred to the NPHC Board of Directors.
- <u>7</u>. All horses must be registered with APHA. Weanlings may show in appropriate classes without papers: however, a copy of the weanling's APHA registration papers must be submitted to the NPHC point keeper by October 31st of that current year to be eligible for weanling awards.

NPHC SPECIAL AWARDS: HIGH POINT MARE HIGH POINT GELDING HIGH POINT STALLION

Horse must exhibit in three (3) different classes/events under eight (8)) different judge per class/event. Categories to be your choice as listed in the 2010 APHA Rule Book. Must show in at least on (1) NPHC two-judge Poor Boy Show.

ALL AROUND HORSE: Horse must exhibit in Open Halter and in at least three (3) different Open Categories under eight (8) different judges per class/event. Categories to be your choice as listed in the 2010 APHA Rule Book. Must show in at least one NPHC two-judge Poor Boy Show.

Al Hooper Memorial Award: High Point Open Rope Horse

Junior Performance Horse: Must exhibit in two (2) categories of performance (2010 APHA Rule Book) Senior Performance Horse: Must exhibit in two (2) categories of performance (2010 APHA Rule Book) High Point Breeding Stock: Halter and Performance to count (Must show in at least 1 class of each)

2010 NEVADA PAINT HORSE CLUB YEAR END AWARD RULES & REGULATIONS

AMATEUR and NOVICE AMATEUR DIVISION (Rules apply to both Amateur and Novice)

- 1. Exhibitor must comply with all rules as listed in the Open Division. Exhibitor/Amateur must sign in at two (2) meetings to be eligible for awards. Exhibitor must be a member in good standing.
- 2. A member can gain points on a one-horse/one-rider basis for High Point Award as well as each class award. Points are NOT transferable. May exhibit more than one (1) horse.
- 3. Exhibitor must hold a current Amateur or Novice Amateur Card depending on Division you are in.
- Amateurs and Novice Amateurs must show under eight (8) judges per class/event of which must include a NPHC Two judge poor boy.

HIGH POINT Classic AMATEUR (ages 19-44) HIGH POINT Master AMATEUR (ages 45 and Over)

These awards will be given to the amateurs with the most accumulated points. Only Amateur classes are to count. The exhibitor and horse must exhibit in at least four (4) different classes/events, under eight (8) different judges per class/event. Must show in at least one (1) NPHC two-judge Poor Boy Show.

HIGH POINT NOVICE AMATEUR

This award will be given to the Novice Amateur with the most accumulated points. Only Novice Amateur classes are to count. The exhibitor and horse must exhibit in at least four (4) different classes/events, under eight (8) different judges per class/event. Must show in at least one (1) NPHC two-judge Poor Boy Show.

YOUTH DIVISION

Exhibitor or a family member as defined by APHA must own horse. Exception: Walk/Trot Exhibitors do not have to own the horse, as these classes are non-APHA approved. Youth shall gain points on a one-horse/one rider basis for youth awards. Youth exhibitor qualifying for youth awards must sign in at two (2) NJPHC meetings (Lead line exhibitors are exempt from the meeting requirement). The exhibitor and horse must exhibit under eight (8) judges per class/event of which includes at least one (1) NPHC two-judge poor-boy.

SPECIAL YOUTH AWARDS: HIGH POINT YOUTH 13 AND UNDER HIGH POINT YOUTH 14-18

Awards given to the youth with the most accumulated points. Youth classes only to count towards these awards. Exhibitor and horse must show in at least four (4) classes/events, eight (8) times per class/event to qualify. Must show in at least one (1) NPHC two-judge Poor Boy Show.

HIGH POINT NOVICE YOUTH 18 AND UNDER

Given to the Novice Youth with the most accumulated points. Novice Youth classes only to count. The exhibitor and horse must exhibit in at least four (4) classes/event under eight (8) different judges per classes/event. Must show in at least one NPHC two judge Poor Boy Show.
