You are responsible for knowing all the rules that pertain to qualifying for awards offered by organizations approving this show. Horses must be pre-entered with at least one entry per horse, or a post entry fee of \$25.00 will be charged.

Send entries and a photocopy of papers plus Membership, Youth, Amateur, and Broodmare cards, if applicable, to the Show Secretary. All owners and exhibitors must have a current APHA membership card in addition to Novice Amateur, Amateur, Amateur Walk-Trot, Youth, and Novice Youth. All necessary temporary cards are available from the show secretary at the show.
